Shedding some light: the world's smallest cinema on New George Street!

Flipside Film Festival brings *flatpack cinema* to the people of Plymouth with its cinema in a shed!

Situated on **New George Street** (outside Waterstones bookstore) from **Tuesday 27th – Friday 30th May**, The Shed will showcase an eclectic programme of films, which have been created using 'endangered' technologies, and practices.

Think oddball animations, experimental artists' films, offbeat comedies and thought-provoking documentaries. The shed will bring you the cream of small gauge cinema, in a convenient city centre location!

It is hoped that this installation will open eyes beyond having the latest high definition camera or TV, and instead encourage a more contemplative, cerebral approach to subject matter: a considered step aside from the tired '*oohs and ahs*' of cinema as spectacle.

Flipside Film Festival runs from **May 21-31** across various Plymouth venues, and aims to provide a platform for both endangered film practices and experiences of our world that are under-represented by mainstream broadcast media.



Flipside Film Festival's screening and workshop events are all open to the public. Venues include **The Voodoo Lounge**, **Plymouth College of Art & Design Cinema**, **The Shed Cinema** (a two-seat cinema to be situated in New George Street) and **Plymouth Arts Centre Cinema**.

Grammy-Winning Don at Flipside

The festival climaxes with a special appearance by filmmaker **Don Letts**, who won a **Grammy Award** for his documentary about seminal British punk band, **The Clash**. There will be a screening of two of Don's feature films (including the Grammy-scooping *Westway to The World*) at **Plymouth Arts Centre** on **May 31st**. This includes a panel discussion of his work and readings from his recent biography "Culture Clash."

Flipside Party: Open to the Public

The festival will conclude with a closing party at **Bar Favela**, Plymouth on **Saturday May 31st**. **Don Letts** will play a reggae DJ set, supported by the city's own DJs **Crusty & Dirty Arry**. The event starts at 10pm and entry is £5
